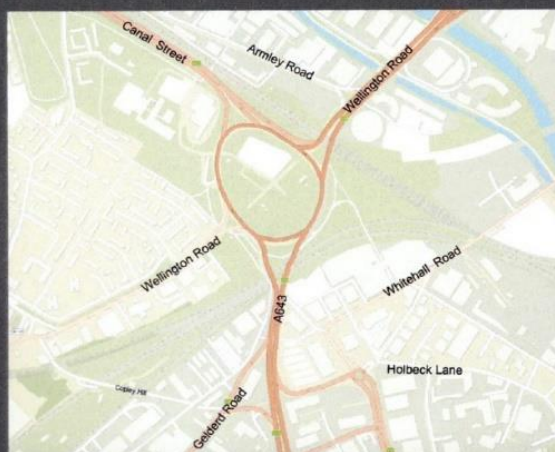
More widely, Leeds City Council is currently developing plans to improve bus journey times and service reliability along the Bradford to Leeds corridor (Bradford Road, Stanningley Road, Stanningley Bypass and Armley Road).

Not only would upgrade works seek to improve conditions at Armley Gyratory Junction itself, but they would also enable wider improvement projects in the city centre and surrounding communities.

Armley Gyratory Junction

The gyratory is a signalised roundabout to the west of Leeds city centre, as shown on the map to the right. It is a key junction and a major entry/exit point for traffic from the northwest of the city centre.
